






Dear 

The Gaming Authority has received your letter dated December 13th 2012. The Gaming Authority welcomes the willingness of your client,  to take into account our prioritisation criteria for the enforcement of illegal games of chance through Internet.

In your letter you confirm that your client  has taken the necessary measures to ensure their website  will not meet our prioritisation criteria. I would like to point out to  that this also should apply to any other Internet sites which are offering games of chance via the Internet and that are aimed at the Dutch market.

Research, undertaken on January 28th 2013, has shown that the website  doesn't meet our prioritisation criteria and therefore we will not focus our attention on your client's website and their activities at this moment. We appreciate  taking the necessary measures to prevent meeting one of the three prioritisation criteria.

Perhaps superfluously, we also wish to point out the following. Offerors of games of chance, which no longer meet (one of) our prioritisation criteria, are not legal because of this. This only means that, in the context of our prioritisation, these offerors will not be faced with our enforcement measures (as yet). Only when a website is not aimed at the Dutch market, for example if that website is not available from an IP-address from the Netherlands and/or the offeror of that website doesn't accept Dutch customers (residing in the Netherlands), that website will not fall within the scope of the Dutch Betting and Gaming act.



Please keep in mind that the prioritisation criteria may evolve over time but at this moment the Gaming Authority does not see a reason to adjust the criteria. When there are reasons to adjust the prioritisation criteria and the Gaming Authority intends to do so, the Gaming Authority will try to inform you well in advance.
