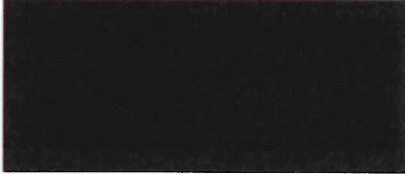



Concerning Approach towards online games of chance

Dear Sir/Madam,

We have sent you or your company a letter dated the 16<sup>th</sup> of September 2013 with reference number 00.016.051. In this letter, we wrote that the websites  will be subjected to a follow-up investigation.

Investigations conducted on November 18, 2013, have shown that the above mentioned websites no longer meet any of our enforcement priority criteria. We appreciate that you have taken the necessary measures to avoid fulfilling these criteria.

It may be superfluous to point out the following. Our enforcement priority criteria are used to set priorities in our enforcement efforts. The fact that our enforcement priority criteria are not fulfilled by a remote gambling service targeting the Dutch market does not imply this service is permitted at law, and does not preclude enforcement against the same service.

Furthermore, please note that our priority criteria are subject to change. We will attempt to inform you when the priority criteria are changed.
