Concerning Reminder: Games of chance via Internet

Dear Sir, Madam,

On June 13th 2012 we wrote you a letter concerning the following.  
Research had shown that you offer games of chance via Internet, inter alia via the  
website [REDACTED] It is possible to participate in the games of chance  
offered on this website from the Netherlands.

As written in our previous letter, games of chance via Internet, aimed at the  
Netherlands, are currently prohibited.

We further indicated that the Gaming Authority will focus its attention on offerors:

- whose website, on which games of chance is played, ends with .nl; and/or
- whose games of chance website has a Dutch language version; and/or
- who advertise on radio, television or in the printed media addressing the Dutch market.

Offerors meeting (one of) the prioritisation criteria listed above will be faced with  
the Gaming Authority's enforcement measures.

Before taking enforcement measures, we allowed you to adjust your advertising  
policies and/or website within two months, so as to ensure that you no longer  
meet the prioritisation criteria. We also requested you to inform us in writing  
within two weeks after the date of our previous letter whether you will take the  
necessary measures.

To date we haven't received a response from you. The set term of two months will  
expire on August 13th 2012.

We urgently request you to inform us that you will take or have taken the  
necessary measures before August 13th 2012, so as to ensure that you no longer  
meet the prioritisation criteria.

We would like to point out to you once more that the Gaming Authority will take  
enforcement measures, if you meet (one of) the prioritisation criteria after set  
date.
